Global Clinical Case Contest

Dental undergraduate and graduate students, with less than 2 years of clinical practice, are invited to participate (repeated participation excluded) by documenting a patient case with photographs and text.

A university should designate a tutor for its participants, and each university can submit up to three entries through its local Dentsply Sirona country organization.

A tutor can range from a dental faculty member to a post-graduate student. Their purpose will be to oversee the student's clinical case.

Clinical Cases and Materials Used

Clinical anterior or posterior restorations are placed using the entire Dentsply Sirona restorative product line. The case must be photo documented and accompanied by text, and submitted in a standardised format provided by Dentsply Sirona.

All Dentsply Sirona products, required for fabricating cases, are available free of charge to participants.

Direct adhesive restorations as well as CEREC Tessera[™] restorations created chairside using the CAD/CAM workflow are eligible for entering the contest.
